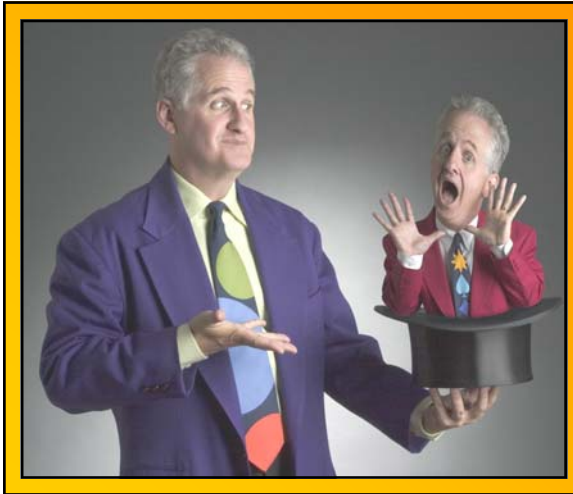


A TOUCH OF MAGIC

Audience participation highlights the fun as children gather "imagination dust" from the air or shout out a magic word. Their eyes glisten with excitement as a shining silver ball magically floats in the air. You'll watch them giggle as coins are plucked from their ears, noses and pigtails.

AN EXPERIENCED PROFESSIONAL

When Danny Orleans was six years old, he told his grandfather, "When I grow up, I'm going to be a magician," — and he was right! Raised in Livingston, New Jersey, Danny performed throughout his teenage years. In 1972, he enrolled at Northwestern University and, while attending college, taught magic classes at community centers and performed his family show throughout the greater Chicago area.

After receiving his degree in elementary education and teaching mathematics and science, Mr. Orleans developed educational magic shows that teachers used as springboards for their curriculum. He toured these shows throughout North America to over 1000 schools and theaters including the Brooklyn Academy of Music, the Detroit Institute of Arts, The International Children's Festival in Toronto and the entire school systems of Bergen County, NJ; Louisville, Kentucky; Evansville, Indiana; and New Orleans.
